dismantled at the end of the project.

All the art has been preserved, however. Installation Gallery, coordinator for last year's visual art festival, has published a catalog that features photographs of the works, as well as extensive documentation and biographical sketches of the 100 artists involved.

Former Escondido Michael Krichman, president of Installation Gallery, called the catalog "one of the best ways for people to appreciate the artistic power and magnitude of the exhibition."

Krichman noted that the art was at 39 sites in the county and Tijuana, in some cases at isolated sites. To see the complete exhibition took most of three days.
