■ In collaboration with **inSite**, two museums in the region — the Centro Cultural Tijuana and the San Diego Museum of Art — jointly organized a single exhibition that weave together the work of contemporary artists and documentary material and artifacts from five urban centers in the Americas — Buenos Aires, Caracas, Mexico City, New York City and São Paulo. The exhibition seek to explore contemporary art's engagement with urban and domestic symptoms of crisis in the city.
